So we begin another year of Catholic education at St. Angela School! This is my second year as principal, and I am excited about the changes we have planned. With your generous support, we have been able to purchase new curriculum materials and introduce more special classes for our scholars. We have also been blessed to hire some outstanding new staff who we believe will continue the tradition of excellence that distinguishes St. Angela School.

We have a new music and choir program, expanded art and physical education classes, and an earlier start to the school day—so we can pack everything in! We have designated first period for religious education and purchased new curriculum materials to assist the teachers. We believe we will all benefit from starting the day with some reflection and prayer. We have introduced a Spanish program; all grades receive one to three Spanish classes per week. The scholars are very enthusiastic about Spanish!

St. Angela received a strong endorsement from the Archdiocese this summer in their approval and

funding for 59 new windows to replace the original wood casement ones. Teachers and scholars alike are thrilled with this pending improvement to our facility.

All of us here at St. Angela are deeply appreciative of your generous and continued support. We are committed to providing our scholars a top tier education grounded in academics, faith, and character development. Your gifts provide us with the resources to continue this mission.

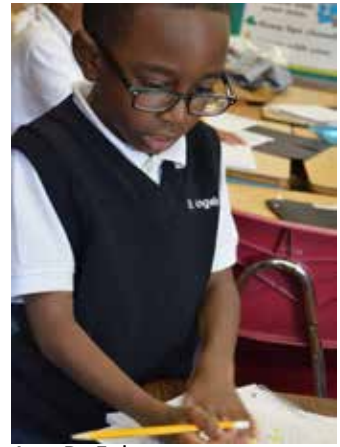

Sister Brian, former Superintendent of Schools for the Archdiocese of Chicago and Chief of Staff for Cardinal Joseph Bernardin, shares some thoughts about Pat's effect on St. Angela.*

We all know Patrick Mahoney was a St. Angela School donor and benefactor and even that he served as Chairman of the Patrons Board. We know that in reality Pat was so much more: public relations agent, investor, unofficial sponsor and—as one young scholar thought—owner. 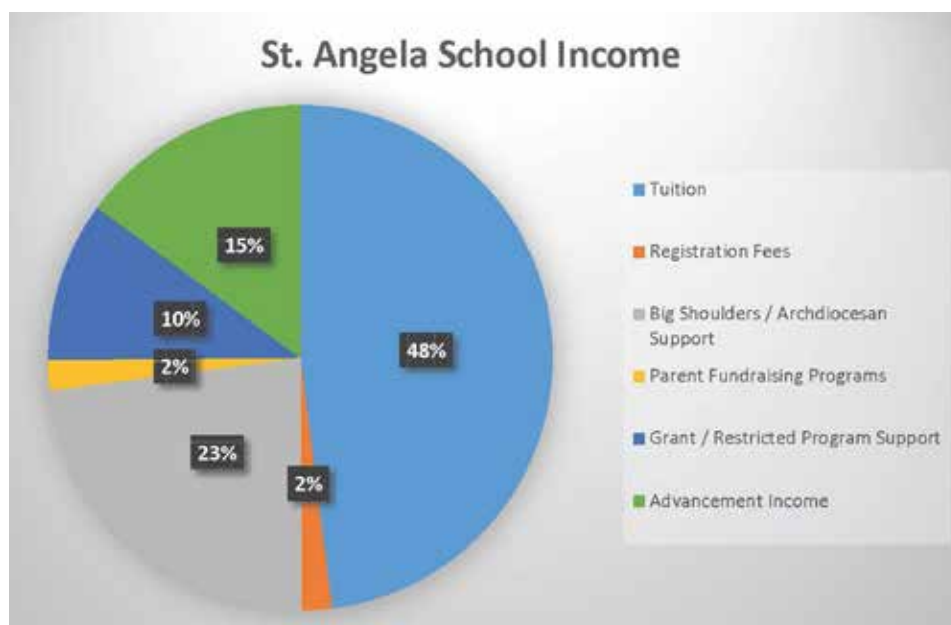
